

Everglade Road Dredging Project Update and Road Closure Notice:

Dear Resident of Greenville,

The Town of Greenville is gearing up to start our Everglade Road Dredging project starting just west of Greenwood Road and extending to the intersection of State Highway 76 near the US Post Office. The project will start around the second to third week of November. During this time, Everglade Road will be closed to thru traffic between 7:30am and 4pm. Everglade Road will be closed at Greenwood Road and also near the State Highway 76 intersection. While operations are underway, please seek alternative routes to your travel destination. This project is phase one of Everglade Watershed dredging. Phase two dredging is in early discussions with the Department of Natural Resources. Phase two is proposed to extend another 2700 linear feet downstream in a previously dredged area. While phase one and two projects are either in early construction or planning, the Town has completed year two of three to open up a stream channel into the Town of Center north of Quarry Road.

Lake and Pond Solutions have completed spraying vegetation for the year along the Bear Creek Stream corridor to Quarry Road in the Town of Center. Work will resume next year for a short section north of Quarry Road. Town staff and Town Board members will evaluate effectiveness of spraying activities in fall of 2016.
