I. Hours of Operation

Monday through Friday 7:30am – 4:00pm (excluding Holidays)

Summer Extended Hours of Operation:

April 1st - November 30th

Monday – Thursday 7:30am – 7:00pm

Friday 7:30am – 4:00pm

Saturday 9:00am – 3:00pm

(excluding Holidays)

The gate will be closed promptly at closing time. Anyone inside of the gate will be allowed to finish unloading yard waste. All loading of materials will be finished at closing time. Gate will be opened to allow resident to exit when they are done unloading yard waste.

II. Admittance to Yard Waste Site

All Town of Greenville residents will need to obtain a windshield decal to enter the yard waste facility. No one will be allowed to drop off or pick up anything from the yard waste facility without a windshield decal. If Town resident is using multiple vehicles to come into the yard waste facility, they will need to purchase multiple decals for each vehicle used. Windshield decals can be purchased at Town Hall or the Municipal Building offices. The cost of the windshield decals will be \$10 for the first decal and \$5 per vehicle after that for vehicles that reside at a single household. Permits are good for one year starting January 1 through December 31. Decals will need to be purchased each year the resident intends to use the yard waste site. The Town yard waste site is for Town of Greenville Residents only. No commercial operators or businesses will be allowed into the site.

*A windshield decal will not be needed to dispose of used oil and antifreeze.

The Town reserves the right to revoke any and all privileges to the yard waste site at any time including revocation of windshield decal without refund.

III. Yard Waste Site Rules

- 1) No Commercial Disposal.
- 2) Yardwaste can be taken in any clean container.

- 3) Yardwaste must be clean and free of debris prior to disposal.
- 4) Residents must de-bag their own yardwaste at the site if brought in bags other than Town approved biodegradable bags.
- 5) No tree stumps, food waste or garbage allowed.
- 6) Root balls under 50lbs accepted.
- 7) Shrubs or trees with root balls attached will not be accepted.
- 8) Brush is accepted up to 12" in diameter and 12' in length. (must weigh less than 75 lbs)
- 9) When unloading brush, brush must be piled neatly with cut ends facing outward in the designated area.
- 10) Residents must unload their own items from their vehicles.
- 11) Free compost and or wood chips may be available at the site during normal hours of operation.
- 12) All wire and metal must be removed from brush and compost before disposing at yard waste site.
Any wire or metal left in brush that causes damage, may be charged back to resident.
- 13) No wreaths are allowed.
