For

Utility Service Permits

Town of Greenville Wisconsin

Effective Date: January 15, 2008

Application Fee:

Permit application fees are as follows:

- ❑ Sites with less than 250' of Utility line installed = **\$50.00** plus **\$0.10** per foot charge parallel to roadway. Each road bore = **\$50.00** additional charge, not to exceed **\$250.00**.
- ❑ Sites with more than 250' of Utility line installed = **\$100.00** plus **\$0.10** per foot charge parallel to roadway. Each road bore = **\$50.00** additional charge, not to exceed **\$250.00**.

Application fee is paid when the permit application is initially submitted to the Town. The application fee is typically paid in full before the permit is issued.

Forfeitures / Fines:

Forfeitures / fines for each day of work without a Utility Service permit vary from **\$25** to a maximum of **\$300** for each day of non-compliance and each occurrence.

The forfeitures / fines are as follows:

<u>Notice of Violation</u>	< 250' of Utility Line	> 250' of Utility Line
Failure to apply for and obtain an Utility Service Permit	\$25	\$150
Failure to develop and implement an erosion and sediment control plan	\$50	\$200
Failure to inspect and monitor erosion and sediments control BMPs	\$30	\$300
Failure to repair, replace or maintain erosion and sediment control BMPs	\$50	\$300
