

## Notice of filing for a rate increase Water customers of Greenville Sanitary District Utilities

The Public Service Commission has recommended a 3% rate increase to be effective on July 1, 2016. On May 10, 2016 the Town Board approved the rate case application and it was filed with the PSC on May 12, 2016. Wisconsin statute 196.193 states that rate increases granted under this statute do not require a public hearing. Our current usage rate for a thousand gallons of water is \$1.60. Implementing the 3% increase will increase the water rate to \$1.65. Due to the increased cost of chemicals and power over the last year, it is important to make small percent increases over time to cover operating expenses.
