Note regarding non-agenda Town related matters: Pursuant to WI Statutes 19.83(2) and 19.84(2), the public may present matters; however, they cannot be discussed or acted upon until specific notice of the subject matter of the proposed action can be given.*

a. Discussion & Possible Action: Glen Valley Drive Block Party

Motion to approve the consent agenda made by Jack Anderson, second by Dean Culbertson. Motion carried 5-0.

6. NEW BUSINESS

a. Public Hearing & Possible Action: Order to amend the Town of Greenville Sanitary District #1 boundaries to include Sec. 35, T22N, R16E CSM 3510 Lot 3 Less HY (PLATTED OUT OF PRT W1/2 SW SEC35-22-16) 3.75AC M/L, N2514/N2518 State Road 76, Town of Ellington. Parcel number 080-089305.  
Resolution to amend the Sanitary District #1 was denied, no action needed.

b. Discussion & Possible Action: Purchase of Snow Pusher for Public Works.  
2017 snow plow budget has a surplus, by using this surplus to purchase the snow pusher it will not need to be budgeted for in 2018. This piece of equipment can be used all year round. Motion to approve the purchase of the snow pusher made by Dean Culbertson, second by Mark Strobel. Motion carried 5-0.

c. Discussion & Possible Action: Additional Crack Filling.  
Motion to approve additional \$40,000 from surplus to be used for crack filling made by Jack Anderson, second by Andy Peters. Motion carried 5-0.

d. Discussion & Possible Action: Additional Asphalt Surface Treatments, GSB-88.  
Dean Schiller, Public Works Supervisor would like to try this new application, it would be applied to the roads earlier in the season to keep moisture in the road

resulting in a longer life. Summer Breeze subdivision is the application area. Motion to approve \$11,000 surplus to be used on additional asphalt surface treatments made by Jack Anderson, Mark Strobel second. Motion carried 5-0.

e. Review of Town Website Upgrades.

At the end of this week we will be proofing with all departments and hopefully going live in a few weeks. Jack is thinking we should do a soft opening and have someone with an English background to go through and check it. Jack would also like to have a blog.
