1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m.

OTHERS PRESENT: Chief Lambie, Mark Evers, Tom Becher and David Rae.

2. POSTING OF AGENDA/APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The agenda has been properly posted. Motion by Mark Strobel, seconded by Mike Woods to approve the agenda. Motion carried 4-0.

3. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Review Fire Department/1<sup>st</sup> Responder issues from the last quarter.

The new truck will be delivered this fall, likely the first part of November.

- b. Discuss any concerns going forward into next quarter.

David Rae from Gold Cross attended the meeting. Mike Woods inquired about accident scenes where a helicopter is in the air, in route but are called off by Gold Cross. David indicated that decisions are made on a case by case basis and they will always find the best way to transport a patient. Sometimes the mode of transportation is dependent upon what else is going in the area. The national standard for response time is 20 minutes or less; their goal is 10 minutes. They now also do debriefings with medics and discuss how they can improve upon each scene to improve trauma care.

Due to the large number of fatal accidents on Hwy. 15, Mark Evers inquired if there has been an update from our Sheriff's Liaison Sgt. Nate Borman from the meeting he attended with the county traffic safety committee. No information as of yet but maybe at the next Town Board meeting.

Mike Woods asked how many persons Gold Cross could handle in the case of mass casualty. David indicated that there are 11 rigs on the road at any given time, with an additional 6 available. A regional approach would be taken and mutual aid would also be utilized. Andy asked if we should do a mock disaster or tabletop. Dave will talk to Chris Schlechta.

Truck 5362 – Out of service 5-7 days for valve and pump replacement and should be back by the end of this week. The vehicle is up for replacement in 2017. 5382 brush truck – there is interest in purchase of the current truck after the new one is in service.

They received four applications for firefighters and interviews will be held in June.

Residents off of Mayflower have a long driveway and at times elements make it difficult for Fire/EMS to provide service. Additional communication will be held with the residents.

June 1<sup>st</sup> is the deadline for the raze order on the Fletcher property.

Silver Lake Fireworks is looking for an alternate site to sell. The owner would like to set up two 40 ft. containers by the Korth property. Chief is concerned about traffic access.

Gold Cross donated an ambulance that is being made into a mobile vet clinic for the Humane Society. The Fire Department did the retrofit. It is the first of its' kind in the nation. The intent is to service veterans who are unable to leave their homes, the elderly that cannot get out, the homeless and low income individuals that who would otherwise not see a veterinarian for their animals.

Discussion was held regarding the entry way and door replacement at the station. Mike will work with Dean on estimates.

EMS – discussion was held regarding current staffing levels. They are fully staffed at 15, but with the number of calls they receive, Andy recommended they increase the staff to 16. It would cost approximately \$5,000 to get a new staff member set up with supplies and a radio. They have 4 applicants with their class already passed, they would just need to be approved by the State. Mark will discuss at their meeting and bring information back to the Town Board. Chris will be at the next first responder meeting to talk about Emergency Management for large events.

The next meeting will be August 15, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.

4. ADJOURNMENT

Motion by Mike Woods, seconded by Mark Strobel to adjourn. Motion carried 4-0.
